ITINERARY

Mokoro Lodge: Arrival in Maun.

Our guide will be meet guests at the lodge (Mokoro Lodge) to give them a pre-trip briefing before dinner. Pick up will also be arranged.

Day 1: Moremi Camping (MGR10) Pick-up from the lodge around **0530hrs** by 2 game drive vehicles and transfer by road to **Moremi Game Reserve**; game drive en-route.

Optional: Scenic flight over the Okavango Delta before we depart on Safari. Pick up from the lodge at 0645 to commence the scenic at 0800hrs. Leave for Moremi immediately after the scenic activity.

Arrive in camp (MGR10) late in the afternoon. Game-drive en-route to camp. The camping crew would have already pitched up tents. Have time to settle in; have an African bucket shower followed by a drink around the bush fire in our new home before settling for dinner.



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Day 2: Moremi Exploration (MGR)

A Full Day Game Drive in Moremi Game Reserve covering xakanaka and Xhini Lagoon as well as third bridge. Packed lunch will be served out in the bush while in the pursuit of amazing sightings. After a sundowner we will take a slow drive towards camp for dinner and a drink around the fire before bed time.

Moremi Game Reserve is situated in the eastern areas of the Okavango and was named after Chief Moremi of the Batawana Tribe. This makes for spectacular game viewing and bird watching, including all major naturally occurring herbivore and carnivore species in the region. The reserve is home to over 400 species of birds, including the African Fish Eagle, the Crowned Crane and the Sacred Ibis.

Day 3: Khwai Camping (KDT) Transfer by road from Moremi to Khwai and a game drive en-route to the new camp.

The back-up crew will drive ahead of the game drive vehicles to set up camp. Do a short game drive to allow the crew to break up camp and heard for the next camping ground. Have lunch along the way under a shade. Do a game-drive along the way. Settle in and have time to absorb the new feel of the new camp before having diner.

Day 4: (Khwai - KDT) Morning breakfast, Full day game-drive in Khwai.

Optional: Mokoro excursion in Khwai giving you a chance to explore the aquatic life of the Khwai river in a traditional dug-out canoe. The serene mokoro excursion brings you closer to beauty of nature and gives a great photography opportunity.

Going out for a full day drive will help on maximizing on time as well as the opportunity to have better wildlife sightings. We will carry our packed lunch which we will find time to relax and eat while out there in the wilderness. We will come back into camp in the afternoon for a shower and dinner before bed.







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The Khwai concession displays outstanding beauty with abundance of dramatic wildlife experiences and the resident Khwai River running through its habitat. This beautiful concession borders the Moremi Game Reserve and is home to herds of elephants, predators and general game.

Day 5: Savuti camping (SV7) - Early morning game-drive transfer from Khwai to Savuti.

Arrive around noon in camp, have lunch and a siesta before the next activity. We will then do an afternoon game drive in Savuti, covering the eastern part of the area.







Savuti area forms the entrance to **Chobe National Park** that is known for diverse and striking landscapes, making it an outstandingly beautiful destination.

Day 6: Full Day Game Drive in Savuti

A full day game drive will increase the chances of spotting more wildlife, you will traverse the drier region of Savuti where bull elephants dot the plains. The now dry **Savuti channel** used to be a source of water for both predators and prey. Savuti can be regarded as one the prime wildlife areas also forming part of the **linyanti** in Chobe.

Day 7: Drive back to Maun from Savuti

In the morning before you go for breakfast, get your luggage ready for the camping crew to load and drop at the lodge.

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Depart for your morning and final game drive activity en-route to Maun to be dropped at Mokoro lodge in the afternoon.

Inclusions: Beverages: We provide juice with breakfast, teas, coffee and mineral water. It is recommended to purchase any additional drinks you may require in Maun. We can assist you with this.

We provide all camping equipment and bedding. Each tent accommodates 2 people on 2 single mattresses. N.B. Parents may share with kids.
